

Collaborations in Light

Large Holographic Art from  Holographics North

For years, internationally known artists have traveled to Burlington, Vermont to produce holograms at Holographics North, Inc., the world's only laboratory for large-scale images. Working with Dr. John Perry, these artists produced a body of work that is only available in this exhibition.

Collaborations in Light contains over 20 white-light transmission holograms that produce 3-dimensional images with vibrant rainbow colors that float in mid-air. These holograms exhibit the extraordinary depth and brilliance that is achieved with large-format holography. Many of the works are animated; some measure 42 x 72 inches – the largest in the world.

Explanatory Panels

Text panels describe the history and development of holography, explain how holograms are made and discuss how they are used in science and industry. The panels are illustrated with photographs and holograms. Artist Statements and biographical sketches are included.

Video Production: A 20-minute video production explains how holograms are made.

Installation and breakdown services are included (freight & travel expenses for installation and breakdown are additional). Sample press release, press photos and PSAs are provided.

Collaborations in Light requires 2000 - 2500 square feet with overhead track lighting.
